 - Concerns with 1st bid not having expertise ~\$3.5k

- Dog waste stations.
 - 1 of 3 installed (rain delays). Working on the other two now that the weather is cooler this week.
- Trash can new delivery date is July 6th.

 - On hold until determine spending for watering trees
- Phase II Retention Pond Status Update

Pool Committee

- Fence Moving is Complete at SW corner and bent panel has been replaced.
- Pool contractor would like to move pool pump gate.
 - Need to weld bent panel with two end pieces. \$16 and we should have enough hardware to do it ourselves. May need help with anchoring post to concrete. (Will ask for help on FB)
- Pool signs have been installed & tables/chairs have been delivered.
- Bathroom supplies & pavilion lights (one is out).
 - Bathroom cleanliness? How is it going?
 - Staying clean, just need more supplies
 - Sprinklers will need to be moved & conduit run for 2nd fob access (handicap gate) before we can pour the concrete.
 - No grass clippings have been found in the pool since new mowers started.
- Need to communicate that people need to clean up after themselves.
 - Trash & pool toys should not be left.

- Pool contractor replaced pool light sensors but now needs to add in a timer to reduce the number of bugs landing in the pool.
 - Little or no cost to HOA
- Modified hours closing at 9pm during the week for noise & closing on Monday for pool shock.
 - Pool to open on 3pm on Monday

Landscape Committee

- Pool flower beds will continue to collect neighborhood plant donations.
 - Considering transplanting some of the smaller trees from Reserve A.
 - planting will resume in the fall/spring.
- Reserve Area A landscape plan
 - Large trees will resume planting in the fall/spring.
 - Committee is putting together a plan for 4 large trees from Phase II and smaller plants.
 - No sprinklers out there, but the 5 gallon watering bags would be a good option there.
 - Include the Herrings in planning the area (they've been maintaining it)
- Mowing contractor How is it going?
 - Going well. Seeing improvement in attention to detail and clean-up
