Swimming Pool Rules and Regulations

NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY

Proof of residency must be on file with Management.

1. Pool is closed on Mondays for maintenance per state recommendation (except Holidays).
2. Residents are responsible for the actions of their guest and may only when resident is present.
3. No children under the age of **16** are permitted without adult supervision.
4. Regular swim wear is required – no cut offs.
5. No baby oil or greasy lotions are allowed in pool.
6. No pets in the pool or pool area.
7. No diving.
8. No running, pushing, wrestling, or rough play in the pool.
9. No alcohol is allowed in the pool or pool area. No intoxicated persons are allowed in the pool.
10. No abusive language or actions.
11. All music must be kept at a low volume.
12. No food or drink allowed in pool. No glass containers of any kind. Use trash receptacles and do not litter.
13. Swimming alone is strictly prohibited.
14. No persons allowed in pool or pool area when pool is closed.
15. You must have a key to enter the pool area. Do not loan your pool key to others and do not open the gate for others. Violation of these rules will result in the loss of pool privileges for the season.

HOA and Management reserves the right to ask anyone to leave the pool or pool area for any reason.

A signed copy of these rules must be on file and any dues or covenant violations must be current as of April 1 for use of pool when season begins. If dues are paid in May when people opens, privileges will begin July
If dues are paid in June, privileges will begin Aug 1. (this does not apply to new homeowners)
